(In order of flowering times)


Botanic Name	Common Name	Leaf	Flowers
<i>Eriochilus cucullatus</i>	Parsons Bands	Single ovate basal leaf, often appearing after flowering. Sometimes hairy.	Jan-Jun
<i>Pterostylis rubescens</i>	Red-tipped Greenhood	Flowering: Leaves up the stem and flowers facing towards the stem. Non flowering: Basal rosettes appear after flowering plants.	Feb-Jul
<i>Pterostylis parviflora</i>	Tiny Greenhood		Mar-July
<i>Acianthus pusillus</i>	Small Mosquito Orchid	Single heart shaped leaf. Dark green on top, purple or green underneath.	Apr-Sep
<i>Pterostylis concinna</i>	Trim Greenhood	Small leaf ground hugging basal rosette	May-Oct
<i>Pterostylis melagramma</i>	Tall Greenhood	Flowering: Leaves up the stem. Non flowering: Basal rosette.	May-Nov
<i>Pterostylis nutans</i>	Nodding Greenhood	Basal Rosette. Leaves with corrugated edges	May-Dec
<i>Cyrtostylis réniformis</i>	Small Gnat Orchid	Single rounded ground hugging leaf with prominent pale veins.	Jun-Nov
<i>Diuris pardina</i>	Leopard Orchid	Multiple grass-like leaves	Jul-Dec
<i>Caladenia praecox</i>	Early Caladenia	Single long thin V profile leaf with red base. Single and multi flowered.	Aug-Sep
<i>Caladenia fuscata</i>	Dusky Fingers	Single long thin V profile leaf, red base. Flower stem purple. Mostly single flowered.	Aug-Oct
<i>Pterostylis alpina</i>	Mountain Greenhood	Basal rosette of large fleshy leaves	Aug-Oct
<i>Diuris chryseopsis</i>	Golden Moths	Multiple grass-like leaves	Aug-Oct
<i>Caladenia parva</i>	Brown-clubbed Spider Orchid	Single lanceolate hairy leaf	Aug-Nov
<i>Caladenia carneae</i>	Pink Fingers	Single long thin V profile leaf with red base. Flower stem green. Single and multi-flowered.	Aug-Nov
<i>Caladenia major</i>	Wax-lip Orchid	Single lanceolate hairy leaf	Aug-Dec

<i>Chiloglottis valida</i>	Common Bird Orchid	Two elliptical basal leaves	Aug-Dec
<i>Caladenia tentaculata</i>	Eastern Mantis Orchid	Single lanceolate hairy leaf	Sep-Nov
<i>Caladenia clavigera</i>	Plain-lipped Spider Orchid	Single lanceolate hairy leaf	Sep-Nov
<i>Caladenia pusilla</i>	Tiny Fingers	Single thin leaf	Sep-Nov
<i>Leptoceras menziesii</i>	Hare Orchid	Single basal leaf	Sep-Nov
<i>Diuris orientis</i>	Wallflower orchid	Multiple grass-like leaves	Sep-Nov
<i>Theelymitra aristata</i>	Great Sun Orchid	Single fleshy upright V profile leaf with red base	Sep-Nov
<i>Theelymitra pauciflora</i>	Slender Sun Orchid	Single upright V profile leaf with red base	Sep-Nov
<i>Theelymitra brevifolia</i>	Peppertop Sun Orchid	Single upright V profile leaf with red base	Sep-Nov
<i>Theelymitra rubra</i>	Salmon Sun Orchid	Single thin upright V profile leaf with red base	Sep-Nov
<i>Theelymitra juncifolia</i>	Rush-leaf Sun Orchid	Single upright V profile leaf with red base	Sep-Nov
<i>Prasophyllum brevilabre</i>	Short-lipped Leek Orchid	Single upright tubular leaf. Often with purple base.	Sep-Dec
<i>Calochilus robertsonii</i>	Purple Beard Orchid	Single fleshy upright V profile leaf, red base and ridge along back of the V.	Sep-Dec
<i>Diuris sulphurea</i>	Tiger or Hornet Orchid	Multiple grass-like leaves	Sep-Jan
<i>Microtis parviflora</i>	Slender Onion Orchid	Single thin upright tubular leaf	Sep-Jan
<i>Theelymitra ixoides</i>	Spotted Sun Orchid	Single upright V profile leaf with red base	Sep-Jan
<i>Pterostylis decurva</i>	Summer Greenhood	No rosette. Only rosettes appearing on non-flowering plants.	Nov-Mar
<i>Dipodium roseum</i>	Rosy Hyacinth Orchid	No leaf. Single purple asparagus like stem	Nov-May
<i>Corunastylis morrisii</i>	Bearded Midge Orchid	Single erect thin vertical tubular leaf, red at base	Nov-May
<i>Corunastylis despectans</i>	Sharp Midge Orchid	Single erect thin vertical tubular leaf, red at base	Dec-Jun

Flowering times show the extreme range. Best flowering times are in the mid months.
